



## Roche Enabling Grant for Novel Initiatives in Transplant Research 2012

### Objectives and Aim

Aim is to identify new paradigms in transplant research that could then lead to large grant funding.

### Funding

\$20,000 research grant.

### Applications

Applications for researchers must be within 10 years of completing higher degree, or establishing an independent research group and must be a financial member of 12 months standing of the Transplantation Society of Australia and New Zealand (TSANZ).

### Closing Dates

A. An initial 1 page letter of intent, A4 Arial 10 font, which should include an outline of the proposed project (rationale, aims, methods, expected outcome and impact) plus contact details, should be lodged with the Honorary Secretary of TSANZ by **5pm Friday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2012**.

B. The 5 best applicants will then be contacted by Friday **13<sup>th</sup> April 2012** and full applications (3 A4 pages, Arial 10 font, including rationale, aims, methods, expected outcome and impact) together with Curriculum Vitae for 1-3 investigators, will be sought with the closing date being **5pm Friday 25<sup>th</sup> May 2012**.

C. Applicants will be advised of the outcome and the successful applicants will be formally announced and presented with their award at the TSANZ Annual Scientific Meeting Annual Dinner on Thursday 28<sup>TH</sup> June 2012 in Canberra.
